Research and Clinical Interests

My research interests are in the fields of basic and clinic vascular surgery.

I had an interest in the management of acute limb ischaemia, designing a national database in collaboration with several leading UK Vascular Departments. This culminated in being awarded the Founder's Prize from the Vascular Society of Great Britain and Ireland .

I have led National and International Studies in the management of Aortic and Venous disease, helping to pioneer keyhole methods of treatment.

Following the award of the American College of Surgeons Travelling Fellowship I have developed clinical pathways and treatments for the management of acute Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT) and its sequelae. Currently I run specialist clinics for patients who have Post Thrombotic Syndrome. These run alongside clinics for patients who have had pulmonary emboli. I have set up processes for the management of acute deep vein thrombosis and have published on the subject as well as contributing to NICE guidance.

I am up to date in vascular surgery and able to provide a medico legal opinion on past and current practice.

I have been in clinical practice in vascular surgery since 1991 and have been a Consultant Vascular Surgeon in Nottingham since 2000 and Honorary Associate Professor since 2012. I deliver a clinical service to an immediate population of 1 million people and therefore regularly manage patients with acute and chronic ischaemia, diabetic foot infections, trauma, and other vascular diseases. I regularly attend departmental Multi-disciplinary meetings.

I receive referrals from farther afield in my specialist area of post thrombotic syndrome

I am involved in a busy medicolegal practice and receive instructions on a weekly basis.

My knowledge and practice is current as I continue to keep up to date by attendance at medical meetings. I subscribe to and receive leading vascular journals which I read on a regular basis and also referee papers for those journals. I have published on an annual basis since the mid 1990s .

I am an appraiser for my employing Trust and have been trained in the assessment of clinicians by the National Clinical Advisory Service.

I am Medical Director for Independent Health Group who provide community based local anaesthetic operations for NHS patients including Hernia Repairs.

I have published numerous papers in vascular surgery and, according to Researchgate, I am in the top 5% of Vascular researchers in the World with an h score of over 26.
