Correspondence <i>The fee will depend on the amount of re-reading of material and editing required.</i>	£400 per hour
Answers to CPR Part 35 Questions <i>The minimum fee is £200</i>	£400 per hour
Informal Teleconference to discuss report (up to 15 minutes) <i>A fee for professional time, charged at £100 per 15 minute increment will apply for longer conversations</i>	No fee
Teleconference with Counsel and Attendance at Legal Conferences <i>A minimum fee of £200 will apply.</i> <i>Cancellation of a conference scheduled between 0900 and 1700 with less than 5 days' notice will be charged £300; no charge for cancellation of conferences planned outside these hours</i>	£400 per hour
Travel Fees for attendance at conference or to see claimants <i>Motoring expenses (55p/ mile) or first class rail travel from Warrington will be added to fee. Travel time is charged at £150 per hour.
